

Motion *no. 4.*

The Parliament of Sint Maarten in its Public meeting of today, Wednesday, January 27, 2016

Considering:

- that in accordance with article 38, paragraph 1, of the Kingdom Charter (hereafter: Charter) the countries of the Kingdom can make mutual agreements;
- that till the dismantling of the Netherlands Antilles on October 10, 2010 a mutual cooperation agreement was applicable between the Netherlands Antilles and Aruba where matters of cooperation were regulated;
- that aforementioned mutual cooperation agreement provided a ministerial cooperation council;
- that despite that regular meetings and cooperation takes place between the countries Aruba, Curaçao and Sint Maarten, a more formal basis for the ministerial cooperation is desirable;
- that the current developments in the area of justice, energy and transportation make a formal a structural ministerial cooperation between the countries necessary;

Resolves:

that the respective Parliaments of Aruba, Curaçao and Sint Maarten will call upon their governments to ascertain as soon as possible in which manner shape can be given to a formal and structural platform for ministerial cooperation between the three countries.
