Motion identification taxi and bus drivers

The Parliament of Sint Maarten in its meeting of today, March 10, 2016;

Considering:

- The motion of the Youth Parliament as adopted that something should be done to increase the trust in public transportation;
- That Tourism is the main pillar of the economy of Sint Maarten;
- That the tourists who visit our island frequently make use of our taxis and buses;
- That buses as a mean of transportation is widely used by the public in general
- The need to make the service to the tourists and our locals more professional and safe;

Resolves:

- To request the Minister of Justice to come with guidelines or adjustment of the Traffic Ordinance or other relevant regulations, to make it mandatory that drivers of taxis and buses, have their identification card and an emergency phone number on a spot in the taxis and buses where it is visible for every passenger when in the taxis and buses;

and proceeds to the order of the day.
