The results of the elections held on August 29th, 2014;

That on August 31st 2014 the leaders of the political parties elected to Parliament Mr Frans Richardson (2 seats) Mr. William Marlin (4 seats) and Mrs. Sarah Wescot-Williams (2 seats) have decided to sign a governing declaration to govern St. Maarten for the period 2014 - 2018;

That the Governor has decided to appoint Mr. William Marlin as "formateur";

## Resolves

To request the Prime Minister to inform the individual Ministers not to make any long term policy, financial and or decisions of such a nature such as granting lands in long lease, bus and taxi licenses, concessions, hiring and placement of personnel in crucial functions, decisions on the waste to energy concession or any other such decisions that may obstruct, or encumber the incoming government from functioning adequately during the next governing term.

To request the Prime Minister to inform the individual Ministers who act as Shareholder Representative of the respective Government owned companies to instruct management and board of these companies to refrain from entering into long term financial commitments, hiring new personnel in management functions, entering into long term agreements and sign contracts that may negatively affect or bind these companies for a long term.
