Dear Honorable Minister Van Hugh C. De Weever,

I hereby request that a copy of the agreement as was referenced in the Daily Herald dated November 15, 2018 which was reportedly signed by Government of St. Maarten, Dutch Minister Legal Protection Mr. Sander Dekker and State Secretary Raymond Knops on October 19, 2018, approximately one month before. Said agreement, according to the article aforementioned, claims "St. Maarten commits to execute a series of measures on the short term to significantly improve the state of the Point Blanche Prison paid for by the local Government".

This agreement is requested to be sent to Parliament as soon as possible to facilitate preparation for the meeting which was postponed today.

Minister is also requested to submit the 30 reports of the Progress Committee of St. Maarten as was mentioned in their presentation to Parliament on October 31, 2018; which reports, to date, have <u>not</u> been received by Parliament.
