Subject: Letter for The Council of Ministers

Honorable President:

Via you Madame President I will like to pose the following Questions to the incumbent Council of Ministers.

On October 10, 2017 Parliament was in receipt of the interim report of the work group National Recovery Plan (NRP) for the reconstruction and the recovery of Sint Maarten.

The interim report provided a preliminary analysis of the economic impact expected due to the loss of the country's main business activities and infrastructure.
