Through the Honorable President of Parliament I would like to request the following information and answers to the queries listed below from the responsible Ministries.

- What is the Ministries policy on recognizing and accepting "breeder documents" (bron documenten) from citizens? Breeder documents (birth certificates, marriage certificates etc.)
- What is the Ministries policy on accepting documents from the Civil Registry Department? (for e.g. registration forms)
- 3. Is the information on the registration forms of the Civil Registry Department accepted by all Ministries?

The aforementioned queries are being posed to the respective ministries because there has been numerous complaints about certain departments requesting the same information from residents when the said information was registered, controlled, verified and accepted by the Civil Registry Department. There seems to be evidence of repetitiveness, and bureaucracy within the various administrations therefore the answer to the aforementioned questions is warranted for further study.
