

Honorable Minister Bourne-Gumbs,

By letter dated January 8, 2015, the Corporate Governance Council (CGC) of St. Maarten copied its advice to the Act. Minister of Public Health, Social Development and Labor, the honorable Mrs. R. Bourne-Gumbs, to the Parliament as is required by law. This advice pertains to the appointment of 2 board members to the board of the St. Maarten Laboratory Services N.V. (SLS).

In aforementioned advice, the CGC advised negatively regarding the nomination of one of the candidate-board members, as well as advised the Minister that the articles of incorporation of the SLS are not in conformity with the Corporate Governance Code and applicable laws and regulations.
