- The impasse surrounding the disbursement of reconstruction funds from the Netherlands/Dutch Kingdom to St. Maarten;
- The welfare of the PEOPLE of St. Maarten and the need to rebuild our social fabric stronger through better housing and social safety nets;
- The wide scale need for reconstruction activities;
- The reduced income of government due to dwindled economic activity;

#### Commit:

- To the principles of integrity, transparency and good governance
- To a clear and actionable economic plan developed in cooperation with the community;
- Manage the labor market and skill development programs to ensure maximum employment for our people;
- To work together to bring about stability, tranquility and hope through fast tracked and sustainable economic development;
- To spare the people of St. Maarten any further political uncertainty and any talk of elections during these difficult times;

### To amend;

• The draft national ordinance Integrity Chamber and include the matters raised in the letter of the Dutch minister for Kingdom Affairs dated October 13, 2017;

#### To instruct:

• The Justice Minister of St. Maarten to negotiate a mutual agreement with his Dutch counterpart to realize the cooperation as recommended in the same aforementioned letter, a copy herewith attached, and the draft presented by the Dutch government to the Prime Minster of St. Maarten on October 31<sup>st</sup>.
