- b) How many of labor permits were granted each year?
- c) Of the residence permits granted in (a) how many of them were for people who had work permits granted to them and/or directors licenses?
- d) What are the difference in requirements for a temporary first time Labor Permit and for a first time Temporary Residence?
- e) What is the minimum, maximum and average length of time for the processing of a residence permit and a labor permit?
